

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine as follows:

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Sec. 1. 29 MRSA §253, as amended by PL 1987, c. 415, §7, is repealed.

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#### STATEMENT OF FACT

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This bill repeals the special registration permit for operation of a motorized invalid chair owned and operated by an invalid person. It also repeals the Secretary of State's authority to restrict the location and time of day for operation of a motorized invalid chair.

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
