Sec. 3. Application. The commercial fishing license fee increase established in section 1 of this Act is effective for commercial fishing licenses sold for each calendar year, beginning with licenses sold for calendar year 1994.

## STATEMENT OF FACT

This bill establishes the Cod Hatchery Fund. Money in the fund must be used to establish and operate 2 cod hatcheries, one of which must be located at the Bigelow Laboratory for Ocean Sciences in West Boothbay Harbor. The bill also increases commercial fishing license fees by \$100 per license to provide the revenues necessary to establish and operate the cod hatcheries. The fee increase is effective for commercial fishing licenses sold for each calendar year, beginning with licenses sold for calendar year 1994.
