SENATE AMENDMENT "A" to S.P. 101, L.D. 279, "Resolve, Creating a Special Commission to Erect a Plaque in the Hall of Flags Honoring Medal of Honor Recipients from Maine"

Amend the resolve in section 3 in the last line (page 1, line 15 in L.D.) by striking out the word "Flags." and inserting in its place the following: 'Flags; and be it further'

Further amend the resolve by inserting at the end before the statement of fact the following:

Sec. 4. Funding. Resolved: That the commission may seek outside sources of funding. Expenditures may not be incurred that have an impact on the General Fund.

FISCAL NOTE

This bill authorizes the commission to seek and accept outside sources of funding and prohibits any expenditures that affect the General Fund.'

STATEMENT OF FACT

This amendment allows the commission to seek outside funding, but prohibits expenditures of General Fund money.
