An Act to Make Supplemental Appropriations in Fiscal Year 1992-93 to Meet Certain Payrolls.

(EMERGENCY)

Emergency preamble. Whereas, Acts of the Legislature do not become effective until 90 days after adjournment unless enacted as emergencies; and

Whereas, the 90-day period may not terminate until after the beginning of the next fiscal year; and

Whereas, certain obligations and expenses will become due and payable on or before June 30, 1993; and

Whereas, in the judgment of the Legislature, these facts create an emergency within the meaning of the Constitution of Maine and require the following legislation as immediately necessary for the preservation of the public peace, health and safety; now, therefore,

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine as follows:

Sec. 1. Supplemental appropriations from General Fund. There are appropriated from the General Fund for the fiscal year ending June 30, 1993, to the department listed, the following sums.

Emergency clause. In view of the emergency cited in the preamble, this Act takes effect when approved.

STATEMENT OF FACT .

This bill makes supplemental appropriations from the General 16 Fund to the Department of Mental Health and Mental Retardation for the fiscal year ending June 30, 1993 in order to meet the 18 February 3, 1993 payrolls at the Augusta Mental Health Institute and the Bangor Mental Health Institute. These appropriations are offset by a corresponding deappropriation available due to the delayed start-up of a group home and savings due to the accelerated conversion of certain programs to federal Medicaid funds.

The balance of the budget needs for fiscal year 1992-93 for the Department of Mental Health and Mental Retardation will be included in a subsequent emergency budget bill for fiscal year 1992-93.
