

4 **Sec. 1. 5 MRSA §17851, sub-§2, §B,** as amended by PL 1989, c.
78, §2, is further amended to read:

6 B. Has at least ~~10~~ 5 years of creditable service or 5 full
8 terms as a Legislator, which may include creditable service
10 as a member of the Maine Legislative Retirement System under
Title 3, section 701, subsection 8, before becoming a member
of the Maine State Retirement System.
