2 Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine as follows:

4 Sec. 1. 12 MRSA §7077, sub-§1-A is enacted to read:

6 1-A. Mandatory license revocation. The commissioner shall
8 revoke and may not grant any hunting license or permit to a
10 person convicted of a violation of section 7406, subsection 5 or
12 a violation involving illegally killing a large game animal for a
14 period of at least one year but not more than 5 years. For
16 purposes of this subsection "large game" means deer, bear, moose
18 and turkeys.

14 STATEMENT OF FACT

16 This bill proposes to make mandatory a hunting license
18 revocation for any person convicted of night hunting or illegally
killing a large game animal.
