48	<u>public comment process, the department and the bureau shall</u> select the 3 standard designs.

STATEMENT OF FACT

This bill directs the Department of Administrative and Financial Services, Bureau of General Services and the Department
of Education to establish 3 standard designs for construction of new public schools built in whole or in part with state funds.
One design each will be selected for elementary schools, middle schools and secondary schools. The bureau will establish a
process that invites submission of school construction designs and permits public comment on school designs before choosing the designs.
