'Sec. 3. 22 MRSA §1599, sub-§4 is enacted to read:

 4. State approval of disclosure documents. A physician
performing abortions in this State shall prepare written materials to furnish to a pregnant woman prior to the performance
of an abortion that contain the information required in subsection 2. Those written materials must be submitted to,
reviewed by and approved by the department before the physician utilizes those materials to satisfy the requirements of this
section.'

Further amend the bill by inserting at the end before the statement of fact the following:

## **'FISCAL NOTE**

The Department of Human Services will incur some minor additional costs to review and approve the informational materials to be provided to pregnant women prior to an abortion. These costs can be absorbed within the department's existing budgeted resources.'
