Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine as follows:

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Sec. 1. 22 MRSA §1063, sub-§4 is enacted to read:

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4. Hepatitis vaccine for volunteer firefighters. The department shall provide a municipality with hepatitis vaccine sufficient to immunize persons who act as firefighters for no compensation for any municipal fire department or incorporated volunteer fire association.

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STATEMENT OF FACT

This bill requires the Department of Human Services to provide hepatitis vaccine to municipalities to immunize volunteer firefighters.
