4	Sec. 1. 12 MRSA §6851, sub-§6, as repealed and replaced by PL 1991, c. 784, §8, is amended to read:
6	6. Fees. The <u>annual</u> fees are as follows:
8	A. Two hundred seventeen dollars for a wholesale seafood license er-a-whelesaleseafoodlicensewithalebster
10	permit; and
12	B. Forty-three dollars for each <u>a</u> supplemental <u>wholesale</u> <u>seafood</u> license: and
14	C. For a wholesale seafood license with a lobster permit
16	and for a supplemental wholesale seafood license with a lobster permit, the fee is the fee established in rules
18	adopted under section 6851-A.
20	Sec. 2. 12 MRSA §6851-A is enacted to read:
22	§6851-A. Wholesale commerce in lobsters; license fees based on volume
24	The commissioner shall adopt rules that establish a schedule
26	of fees for wholesale seafood licenses with lobster permits that are based on volume. The rules must take effect on January 1,
28	1994 and must:
30	1. Establish volume categories. Authorize the license holder to engage in all the activities in section 6851,
32	subsection 2 and to engage in the purchase, sale, processing, shipment or transport of not more than a specified volume, in
34	<pre>pounds, of whole lobsters, lobster meat or lobster parts. The rules must establish at least 3 volume categories; and</pre>

48	STATEMENT OF FACT
50	This bill requires the Commissioner of Marine Resources to adopt rules establishing a license fee for wholesale lobster

dealers that reflects the annual volume of lobsters the dealer is authorized to purchase, sell, process, ship or transport. On January 1, 1994, the law setting the current fee for a wholesale seafood license with a lobster permit is amended with language that accommodates the fee structure established by the commissioner.
