COMMITTEE AMENDMENT " $\mathcal{H}$ " to H.P. 275, L.D. 353, Bill, "An Act to Amend the Charter of the North Berwick Water District"

Amend the bill by inserting after the title and before the emergency preamble the following:

'Mandate preamble. This measure requires one or more local units of government to expand or modify activities so as to necessitate additional expenditures from local revenues but does not provide funding for at least 90% of those expenditures. Pursuant to the Constitution of Maine, Article IX, Section 21, two thirds of all of the members elected to each House have determined it necessary to enact this measure.'

Further amend the bill by striking out all of section 1 and inserting in its place the following:

'Sec. 1. P&SL 1981, c. 54, §9, 2nd sentence, as amended by P&SL 1983, c. 26, §3, is further amended to read:

The district by vote of its board of trustees, and without district vote except as otherwise provided in this section, is 34 also authorized to issue, from time to time, bonds, notes or 36 other evidences of indebtedness of the district in the an amount or amounts, not exceeding the sum of \$1,500,000outstanding at any one time, except for indebtedness to fund 38 projects specifically mandated by the State Government or Federal 40 Government, bearing interest at such a rate or rates, and having such terms and provisions as the trustees shall determine; 42 provided-that,--except-for-not-in-excess-off. Except in the case of indebtedness not exceeding \$800,000 in principal amount of 44 notes and bonds at any one time outstanding to-be issued by vote

of the trustees without district vote for the purposes of acquiring properties of the North Berwick Water Company and, making certain improvements, and for-the purpose of acquiring a new water supply and making further improvements, in the case of any other votes by the trustees to authorize bonds or notes to pay for the acquisition of property, for the cost of a water system or part thereof, for renewal or additions or for other improvements in the nature of capital costs, the estimated cost of which, singly or in the aggregate included in any one financing, is \$150,000 or more, or for renewing or refunding existing indebtedness, notice of the proposed debt and of the general purpose or purposes for which it was authorized shall must be given by the clerk by publication at least once in a newspaper having a general circulation in the Town of North Berwick.'

Further amend the bill by inserting at the end before the statement of fact the following: 18

## **'FISCAL NOTE**

This bill requires local units of government to make additional expenditures to pay for the cost of the required local 24 Pursuant to the Mandate Preamble, the votes of two election. thirds of all members elected to each House exempt the State from 26 the constitutional requirement to fund 90% of the additional 28 local cost of these requirements.'

### STATEMENT OF FACT

34 This amendment adds a municipal mandate preamble to the bill providing that the costs associated with the mandate imposed 36 pursuant to the Constitution of Maine, Article IX, Section 21 by the local referendum provision of the bill are not funded by the 38 State.

40 This amendment also replaces section 1 of the bill. Under this amendment, as in the original bill, the debt limit of the 42 North Berwick Water District is increased from \$1,500,000 to \$3,000,000. This amendment also makes certain clarifying changes 44 in the language of the charter and adds a fiscal note to the bill.
