4 Sec. 1. 5 MRSA §1812-G is enacted to read:

6 §1812-G. School bus purchases

8 All school bus purchases approved under Title 20-A, section
10 5401, subsection 15 must be purchased through the Bureau of
General Services. The bureau shall make all bus purchases in
accordance with section 1812.

12 Sec. 2. 20-A MRSA §5401, sub-§15, ¶E is enacted to read:

14 E. All school bus purchases must be made through the Bureau
16 of General Services.

18 **STATEMENT OF FACT**

20 This bill requires all school units or administrative
22 districts to go through the Bureau of General Services for school
bus purchases.
