

Sec. 1. 5 MRSA §1742-E is enacted to read:

§1742-E. Administration and supervision of bond issues authorized
for capital repairs, improvements and construction

The Director of the Bureau of General Services may use up to
1 1/2% of the proceeds of any bond issue related to the capital
repair, improvements or construction of state facilities for the
purpose of administering and supervising the construction or
repair authorized.
