COMMITTEE AMENDMENT "A" to H.P. 280, L.D. 367, Bill, "An Act to Increase Unenrolled Voter Participation in Primary Elections"

Amend the bill by striking out the title and substituting the following:

**'An Act to Allow Unenrolled Voter Participation in Primary Elections'**

Further amend the bill by inserting before the statement of fact the following:

**'FISCAL NOTE**

The additional local costs of allowing unenrolled voter participation in primary elections will require 90% funding by the State as a state mandate pursuant to the Constitution of Maine. The General Fund appropriations required to fund these costs can not be estimated at this time.'

**STATEMENT OF FACT**

This amendment adds a fiscal note to the bill.
