COMMITTEE AMENDMENT "A" to H.P. 286, L.D. 373, Bill, "An Act Regarding Reimbursement for Sand and Salt Storage Facility Construction"

Amend the bill in section 1 by striking out all of the amending clause (page 1, lines 3 and 4 in L.D.) and inserting in its place the following:

'Sec. 1. 23 MRSA §1852, as enacted by PL 1987, c. 793, Pt. A, §5, is amended by adding at the end 2 new paragraphs to read:'

Further amend the bill in section 1 by inserting at the end the following:

'The department may not reimburse a municipality or county under this section or section 1851 for that portion of construction expenses paid for with a grant awarded in accordance with Public Law 1991, chapter 849, section 3 or under the Community Development Block Grant Program.'

Further amend the bill by inserting at the end before the statement of fact the following:

**'FISCAL NOTE**

This bill expands the reimbursement guidelines for salt and sand storage facilities to include facilities already constructed. This expansion will make more municipalities eligible for a fixed amount of existing funds, primarily from a Highway Fund bond issue.'

10 also adds a fiscal note.
