HOUSE AMENDMENT "A" to COMMITTEE AMENDMENT "A" to H.P. 292,  
L.D. 379, Bill, "An Act to Require an Employer Majority on the  
Board of Governors of the Workers' Compensation Residual Market  
Mechanism"

Amend the amendment in section 2 by striking out all of  
subsection 5-A (page 2, lines 34 to 37 in amendment) and  
inserting in its place the following:

'5-A. Immunity. Individuals who serve on the board of  
governors are deemed to be employees within the meaning of Title  
14, section 8102 and are personally immune from civil liability  
pursuant to Title 14, section 8111, subsection 1, paragraph C.'
