SENATE AMENDMENT "A" to COMMITTEE AMENDMENT "A" to H.P. 292, L.D. 379, Bill, "An Act to Require an Employer Majority on the Board of Governors of the Workers' Compensation Residual Market Mechanism"

Amend the amendment in section 2 by striking out all of subsection 5-A and inserting in its place the following:

'5-A. Immunity. A member of the board of governors for the workers' compensation residual market pool created by the Insurance Rule, Chapter 440 is immune from liability except for willful misconduct by a board member in the performance of the duties of a board member.'

STATEMENT OF FACT

With regard to members of the board of governors of the workers' compensation residual market pool, this amendment deletes immunity under the Maine Tort Claims Act and substitutes immunity from liability except for willful misconduct.
