	Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine as follows:
2	Sec. 1. 12 RADEA $97107$ A cmb $81$
4	Sec. 1. 12 MRSA §7107-A, sub-§1, as amended by PL 1991, c. 443, §13, is repealed and the following enacted in its place:
б	<b>1. Eligibility.</b> The following provisions govern eligibility for hunting with a muzzle-loader.

10	A. Any person 16 years of age or older at the beginning of the special season established under subsection 4 may obtain
12	<u>a muzzle-loading license from the commissioner or the commissioner is authorized agent, provided that the person</u>
	possesses a valid license to hunt big game.
14	B. Any person 10 years of age or older and under 16 years
16	of age may obtain a muzzle-loading license from the
18	commissioner or the commissioner's authorized agent, provided that the person possesses a valid junior hunting
20	license.
22	<u>C. No person 10 years of age or younger may hunt with a muzzle-loader.</u>
24	Sec. 2. 12 MRSA §7107-A, sub-§1-A is enacted to read:
26	<b>1-A. Form of license.</b> The muzzle-loading hunting license must be in the form of a stamp that must be affixed to the
28	person's big game hunting license or junior hunting license. The
30	stamp must bear the words "RIGHT TO BEAR ARMS."
32	STATEMENT OF FACT
34	This bill makes the minimum age for eligibility for a muzzle-loading license to hunt deer the same as the minimum age
36	for a general hunting license: 10 years of age. This bill also restructures the relevant provision of law for the purposes of
38	clarity.
