8	1. Definitions. As used in this section, unless the
	context otherwise indicates, the following terms have the

12	A. "Commercial truck" means a motor truck that has a gross
	vehicle weight rating or a registered weight of 26,001 or
14	more pounds.
16	B. "Left lane" means the travel lane furthest to the left.
18	2. Traveling in left lane; adverse weather conditions. The
	operator of a commercial truck on a divided limited-access
20	highway may not drive in the left lane when the speed limit on
	that highway has been lowered, in accordance with section 1251,
22	due to adverse weather conditions.
24	3. Exemption. Highway maintenance vehicles meeting the
	definition of commercial truck are exempt from this section while
26	engaged in highway maintenance.
