

2 **Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine as follows:**

4 **Sec. 1. 30-A MRSA §5684**, as amended by PL 1991, c. 847, §4,  
6 is repealed.

8 **STATEMENT OF FACT**

10 In November of 1992, the people of this State approved an  
12 amendment to the Constitution of Maine to provide for state  
14 funding of any mandate imposed on municipalities. State funding  
16 for mandated programs was previously governed by the Maine  
Revised Statutes, Title 30-A, section 5684. This bill repeals  
the statutory provisions formerly governing unfunded state  
mandates.
