Resolve, to Increase Efficiency and Reduce Costs for State Agencies.

2 Resolved: That the Department of Administrative and Financial Services shall provide a program of high performance work organization.

1. Program. The program shall consist of a compact made between the Department of Administrative and Financial Services
and the participating state agency. All state agencies must submit a proposal no later than October 1, 1993 for the reorganization of a high performance work organization based on the following principles:

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 A. A consumer-oriented approach to service delivery,
 stressing ease of client access and quality of service. This approach must include a plan of regular evaluation by
 consumers of agency services;

- B. A decrease in the number of management levels and an increase of decision-making responsibilities of frontline workers;
- C. Full participation of agency employees in developing the reorganization plan, including participation of affected
   collective bargaining representatives;
- 26 D. A commitment to maintaining the jobs of workers who participate in the reorganization process through 28 retraining, reassignment and other mechanisms and the creation of job ladders; and

E. The use of professional facilitators to manage the change process.

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 2. Selection. The Department of Administrative and Financial Services shall select the Department of Human Services
 36 and one additional agency to participate in the program based on the plans submitted by agencies. Other state agencies may
 38 volunteer to participate subject to approval of the Department of Administrative and Financial Services.

**3. Goals established.** The Department of Administrative and 42 Financial Services shall assist selected agencies in the reorganization process, including:

- A. Facilitating necessary communication and cooperation 46 with other agencies;
- B. Setting a target figure, in cooperation with the selected agencies, for savings to be achieved through the reorganization process; and

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c. Allowing selected agencies to retain, for program purposes, a specified percentage of any savings gained above the target amount.

Report. The Department of Administrative and Financial 4. 6 Services shall report to the Joint Standing Committee on State and Local Government on the progress of the high performance work organization program, including legislation, by January 15, 1994.

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#### STATEMENT OF FACT

 $\mathbf{14}$ This resolve requires the Department of Administrative and Financial Services to develop a program of high performance work organization. All state agencies will be required to submit a 16 plan to the department and 2 will be selected to participate in a 18 pilot program, one of which will be the Department of Human Services.

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
