COMMITTEE AMENDMENT " A " to S.P. 138, L.D. 429, Bill, "An Act to Provide for the 1993 and 1994 Allocations of the State Ceiling on Private Activity Bonds"

Amend the bill in section 2 in the 4th line (page 1, line 39 in L.D.) by striking out the following: "\$5,000,000" and inserting in its place the following: '\$15,000,000'

Further amend the bill in section 4 in the 2nd line (page 2, line 8 in L.D.) by striking out the following: "Twenty-five" and inserting in its place the following: 'Fifteen'

Further amend the bill by inserting at the end before the statement of fact the following:

**FISCAL NOTE**

The establishment of the allocations of the state ceiling on private activity bonds for calendar years 1993 and 1994 will not affect the general or moral obligation of the State.'

**STATEMENT OF FACT**

This amendment amends the original bill to provide an additional \$10,000,000 of state ceiling to the Finance Authority of Maine for the calendar year 1993 and reduces the allocation to the Maine Educational Loan Authority in 1993 by \$10,000,000.
