These costs can be absorbed within the department's existing budgeted resources. 6 8 If the Superintendent of Insurance is recalled by the voters, the Department of the Secretary of State will require an additional General Fund appropriation for an additional statewide 10 The amounts will depend upon the timing of the election. election.' 12 14 STATEMENT OF FACT 16 This amendment is the minority report of the Joint Standing 18 Committee on Banking and Insurance. It adds qualifications for the Superintendent of Insurance and adds a recall provision for wrongful conduct, performance of a duty in an improper manner, 20 commission of a crime and willful neglect of or failure to perform a duty. 22

This amendment adds a fiscal note to the bill.
