An Act Regarding Community Health Centers.

#### Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine as follows:

Sec. 1. 22 MRSA §2142, sub-§3, as amended by PL 1989, c. 119, §1, is further amended to read:

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Home health care provider. "Home health care provider" 6 3. means any business entity or subdivision thereof, whether public or private, proprietary or not for profit, which that is engaged 8 in providing acute, restorative, rehabilitative, maintenance, preventive or health promotion services through professional 10 nursing or another therapeutic service, such as physical therapy, home health aides, nurse assistants, medical social work, 12 nutritionist services or personal care services, either directly 14 or through contractual agreement, in a client's place of residence. This term does not apply to any sole practitioner providing private duty nursing services or other restorative, 16 rehabilitative, maintenance, preventive or health promotion services in a client's place of residence or to municipal 18 entities providing health promotion services in a client's place of residence. "Home health care provider" does not include a 20 community health center, as defined in section 3174-L, subsection Beginning October 1, 1991, "home health care provider" 22 1. includes any business entity or subdivision thereof, whether 24 public or private, proprietary or nonprofit, which that is engaged in providing speech pathology services.

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# Sec. 2. 22 MRSA §3174-L is enacted to read:

## §3174-L. Community health centers authorized to perform case anagement

32 <u>1. Community health center defined.</u> As used in this section, "community health center" means an incorporated anonprofit health facility that provides comprehensive primary health care to citizens in rural areas.

2. Authorization to perform case management. By October 1, 38 1993, the department shall adopt rules making community health centers eligible for Medicaid reimbursement for case management 40 services for persons receiving home-based health services.

## STATEMENT OF FACT

This bill requires that community health centers be 46 authorized providers of case management services in the Medicaid program when those services are provided to people receiving 48 home-based health services.

50 The bill also clarifies that community health centers are not required to be licensed as home health care providers.

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
