
SENATE AMENDMENT "A" to H.P. 356, L.D. 459, Bill, "An Act Regarding Seating on a Motorcycle or Motor-driven Cycle"

Amend the bill in section 2 in that part designated "~~§960-A.~~" in subsection 1 in paragraph E in the 2nd line (page 1, line 27 in L.D.) by striking out the following: "2 or" and in the last line (page 1, line 28 in L.D.) by striking out the following: ", whichever is less"

STATEMENT OF FACT

The bill limited the number of passengers in a motorcycle sidecar to 2 or the number of seats for which the sidecar is designed, whichever is less. This amendment strikes the 2-passenger limitation and defers to the recommendations of the sidecar manufacturers by limiting the number of passengers in sidecars to the number of permanent seats for which the sidecar is designed.
