COMMITTEE AMENDMENT "A" to H.P. 359, L.D. 462, Bill, "An Act to Provide Greater Access to Private Roads during Emergencies"

Amend the bill by striking out everything after the enacting clause and before the statement of fact and inserting in its place the following:

Sec. 1. 23 MRSA §3105 is amended to read:

§3105. Use of town equipment

The inhabitants of any town or village corporation at a legal town or village corporation meeting may authorize the selectmen of the town or assessors of the village corporation to use its highway equipment on private ways within such that town or village corporation, whenever such the selectmen or assessors deem determine it advisable in the best interests of the town or village corporation for fire and police protection and for emergency rescue purposes.

STATEMENT OF FACT

This amendment replaces the original bill. The amendment clarifies that a town may authorize the use of its highway equipment on private ways for emergency rescue purposes as well as for fire and police protection.
