SENATE AMENDMENT "A" to COMMITTEE AMENDMENT "A" to H.P. 365, L.D. 468, "Resolve, Creating the Kennebec County Law Enforcement Examination Commission"

Amend the amendment by inserting after the first indented paragraph after the title the following:

'Mandate preamble. This measure requires one or more local units of government to expand or modify activities so as to necessitate additional expenditures from local revenues but does not provide funding for at least 90% of those expenditures. Pursuant to the Constitution of Maine, Article IX, Section 21, two thirds of all of the members elected to each House have determined it necessary to enact this measure.'

Further amend the amendment in the next to the last indented paragraph before the fiscal note in the first line (page 2, line 2 in amendment) by striking out the following: "bill" and inserting in its place the following: 'resolve'

Further amend the amendment by striking out all of the fiscal note and inserting in its place the following:

FISCAL NOTE

This resolve requires local units of government to make additional expenditures to create the Kennebec County Law Enforcement Examination Commission and requires the commission to report to the board of commissioners for Kennebec County and the Kennebec County Advisory Budget Committee by October 1, 1993. Pursuant to the mandate preamble, the 2/3 vote of all members
