COMMITTEE AMENDMENT "A" to H.P. 366, L.D. 469, Bill, "An Act to Limit the Number of Bills That May Be Filed by a Legislator"

Amend the bill in section 1 in that part designated "§5." in subsection 1 in the 2nd line (page 1, line 8 in L.D.) by striking out the following: "total" and inserting in its place the following: 'maximum'

Further amend the bill in section 1 in that part designated "§5." in subsection 1 in the 2nd line (page 1, line 8 in L.D.) by inserting after the following: "bills" the following: ', as a prime sponsor.'

Further amend the bill by inserting at the end before the statement of fact the following:

FISCAL NOTE

Limiting the number of bills that can be submitted by individual legislators will not significantly affect the current resources or operations of the Legislature.'

STATEMENT OF FACT

This amendment uses "maximum" instead of "total" and adds "as a prime sponsor" for clarification purposes and also adds a fiscal note to the bill. This amendment is the minority report of the Joint Standing Committee on State and Local Government.
