SENATE AMENDMENT "A" to H.P. 366, L.D. 469, Bill, "An Act to Limit the Number of Bills That May Be Filed by a Legislator"

Amend the bill in section 1 in that part designated "S5." in subsection 1 in the 2nd line (page 1, line 8 in L.D.) by striking out the following "10" and inserting in its place the following: '7'

Further amend the bill in section 1 in that part designated "S5." in subsection 1 by inserting at the end the following: 'A member of the Legislature may submit up to 3 additional bills in a regular session upon approval by a vote of 2/3 of the members of the Legislative Council.'

STATEMENT OF FACT

This amendment reduces the number of bills that a member may file without review from 10 to 7 and allows up to 3 additional bills to be submitted upon approval by a vote of 2/3 of the members of the Legislative Council.
