

2 Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine as follows:

4 Sec. 1. 3 MRSA §5 is enacted to read:

6 **§5. Bill submission**

8 **1. Limitation.** A member of the Legislature may submit a  
total of 10 bills for introduction during each regular session of  
the legislative biennium.

10 **2. Exception.** Nothing in this section may be construed to  
12 limit the number of bills that may be submitted by the Governor  
or the Executive Department.

16 **STATEMENT OF FACT**

18 This bill limits the number of bills that a Legislator may  
20 sponsor during each legislative session but allows an exception  
22 for the number of bills that may be submitted by the Governor and  
the Executive Department.
