COMMITTEE AMENDMENT "A" to H.P. 369, L.D. 472, Bill, "An Act to Facilitate the Payment and Collection of Safety Education and Training Fund Assessments"

Amend the bill by inserting before the statement of fact the following:

**FISCAL NOTE**

Payment of late penalties will result in an insignificant increase of General Fund revenues from certain insurers and self-insurers who must pay assessments to the Safety Education and Training Fund.

The Department of Labor will incur some minor additional costs to administer penalty provisions of the Safety Education and Training Fund. These costs can be absorbed within the department's existing budgeted resources.

The additional workload and administrative costs associated with the minimal number of new cases filed in the court system can be absorbed within the budgeted resources of the Judicial Department. The collection of additional fines may increase General Fund revenues by a minor amount.'
