COMMITTEE AMENDMENT "A" to S.P. 148, L.D. 480, Bill, "An Act to Provide Flexibility in Establishing Payroll Schedules for Municipal Employees"

Amend the bill in section 1 in subsection 1 in the 3rd line from the end (page 1, line 21 in L.D.) by inserting after the following: "employee-" the following: 'Municipalities shall pay their employees at least once every 2 weeks unless the employee agrees to be paid under a less frequent pay schedule.'

STATEMENT OF FACT

The amendment requires municipalities to pay their employees at least once every 2 weeks. The municipality may pay on a less frequent pay schedule only if the employee agrees to the longer interval.
