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	<u>A health care provider upon request by a consumer shall</u>
12	provide the consumer with a written estimate of the cost to the
	consumer of providing the services about which the consumer has
14	inquired or that the provider has recommended. A provider may
16	not charge a consumer in excess of this estimate unless a revised estimate is provided to the consumer or the consumer's designated
10	representative prior to the service being provided.

	If a provider is required by law to provide the consumer
20	with a bill of rights, information concerning the opportunity to
	<u>obtain this estimate must be included in it. If no bill of</u>
22	rights is required, prior to providing services, the provider
2.4	shall provide in writing to the consumer notification of this
24	opportunity or post a notice concerning it in a place where it is reasonably likely to be seen by consumers prior to agreeing to
26	receive services from the provider.
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30	STATEMENT OF FACT
32	This bill requires health care providers to give to
34	patients, upon request, a written estimate of the cost of
34	providing the services requested by the patient or recommended by the doctor.
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
