COMMITTEE AMENDMENT "A" to S.P. 152, L.D. 484, Bill, "An Act to Amend the Maine Nuclear Emergency Planning Act"

Amend the bill by striking out all of sections 3 and 4 and inserting in their place the following:

Sec. 3. Allocation of Maine Nuclear Emergency Planning Fund.
Income to the Maine Nuclear Emergency Planning Fund for fiscal years 1993-94 and 1994-95 must be segregated, apportioned and disbursed as designated in the following schedule.
