Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine as follows:

Sec. 1. 28-A MRSA §707-A is enacted to read:

Notwithstanding section 707, a wholesale licensee may extend8credit on purchases of malt beverages and table wine to a retail
licensee for 30 calendar days from the date of delivery.10Wholesale licensees shall report immediately to the Bureau of
Alcoholic Beverages and Lottery Operations a retail licensee who12fails to pay within 30 days of the date of delivery for malt
beverages and table wine purchased under this section. The14retail licensee is prohibited from purchasing any malt beverages
or table wine until the indebtedness is fully paid.16

STATEMENT OF FACT

20 This bill allows but does not require wholesale liquor sellers to extend credit to retail liquor sellers for 30 days for 22 the purchase of malt beverages and table wine. Retail sellers who fail to pay the balance within 30 days of delivery must be 24 reported to the Bureau of Alcoholic Beverages and Lottery Operations are prohibited from making additional purchases until 26 their indebtedness is paid in full.
