Distribution to community coordinating committees. Notwithstanding section 3873, the bureau shall distribute income available under this section to the community coordinating committees created chapter 1057. The bureau under distribute the income en--a--per--eapita--basis among all the coordinating committees, with each coordinating receiving an amount that reflects the pepulation demographics of its area of jurisdiction. The community coordinating committees shall use funds received under this subsection to award direct grants for the development and operation of prevention programs and to fund prevention programs and activities sponsored by the committees.
