COMMITTEE AMENDMENT "A" to H.P. 382, L.D. 495, Bill, "An Act Regarding Bow Hunting"

Amend the bill by inserting before the statement of fact the following:

FISCAL NOTE

Allowing a person who has killed a deer during the special archery season to kill a 2nd deer during the regular firearm season will result in an insignificant increase of General Fund revenues from additional regular deer hunting license fees.'

STATEMENT OF FACT

This amendment, which is the minority report of the Joint Standing Committee on Inland Fisheries and Wildlife, adds a fiscal note to the bill.
