

Sec. 1. 12 MRSA §7102, sub-§4, ¶D is enacted to read:

D. Notwithstanding section 7458, subsections 1 and 2, a
person may hunt for and kill a second deer with a firearm
during the firearm season for deer if that person has taken
a deer with bow and arrow during the special open season for
archery hunting.
