HOUSE AMENDMENT "A" to COMMITTEE AMENDMENT "A" to H.P. 406,
L.D. 519, Bill, "An Act to Exempt Gravel Pits with Less Than 5
Unreclaimed Acres from Regulation by the Department of
Environmental Protection under the Site Location of Development
Act"

Amend the amendment in section 5 by inserting at the end the
following:

§490-K. Multiple violations

The department shall issue a stop-work order under section
490-H for any borrow pit that has been found in violation of the
performance standards in this article on more than 2 separate
occasions. The operator of that borrow pit must file an
application for a permit under article 6 and may not commence
operations at that borrow pit until that license is obtained.'

STATEMENT OF FACT

The amendment requires that a borrow pit operating under the
performance standards of the site location of development laws
cease operations and apply for a site law permit if that borrow
pit violates the performance standards on more than 2 occasions.
