STATEMENT OF FACT

2 This amendment removes language from the majority report
4 that would allow the Department of Environmental Protection to
6 grant variances from the performance standards. The amendment
8 also clarifies that excavations are prohibited in any
10 significant wildlife habitat area, including significant wildlife
habitats that are not mapped and not located within another
protected natural resource.
