

5 6. Church buses and day-camp buses. Church buses and  
6 day-camp buses must be inspected annually and must meet the  
7 inspection requirements imposed by section 2017.

10 STATEMENT OF FACT

12 This bill extends the inspection requirements imposed on  
13 school buses to include church and day-camp buses, except church  
14 and day-camp buses only have to be inspected once a year.
