	Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine as follows:
2	Sec. 1. 35-A MRSA §102, sub-§8, as enacted by PL 1987, c. 141,

6	8. Gas utility. "Gas utility" includes every person, its that person's lessees, trustees, receivers or trustees appointed
8	by any court owning, controlling, operating or managing any gas plant for compensation within this State, except where when gas
10	is made or produced on and distributed by the maker or producer
12	through private property alone solely for its own tenants and not for sale to others, or where when the gas is sold solely for use in vehicles fueled by natural gas or when the gas is sold in
14	liquid form in individual containers or is delivered in bulk in liquid form to a central tank that serves less than 10 customers
16	and no portion of which is located in a public place.

22	The following provisions govern rates for encouraging use of natural gas in vehicles.
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26	1. Special rates established. Upon application of a gas utility, the commission shall establish special rates for sales
28	of natural gas:
30	A. Directly to customers for use in vehicles fueled by natural gas; and
32	B. To any customer of the utility who is engaged in the
34	business of reselling the natural gas for use in vehicles fueled by natural gas.
36	Any rate approved by the commission pursuant to this section must be designed to encourage the use of natural gas to fuel vehicles,
