24 for fiscal year 1993-94 of \$17,128 from the Edward Byrne Memorial
26 State and Local Law Enforcement Formula Program to support a
missing children information clearinghouse project.

28 The Department of Public Safety will require a Federal
Expenditure Fund allocation of \$17,128 in fiscal year 1993-94 for
30 a part-time Clerk Typist II position and general operating
expenses to collect and disseminate information as part of the
32 Missing Children Information Clearinghouse. The Department of
Public Safety will have an opportunity to apply for additional
34 funding in fiscal year 1994-95 from the Edward Byrne Memorial
State and Local Law Enforcement Assistance Program.

36 The Department of Public Safety will require a General Fund
appropriation and Highway Fund allocation totaling \$17,128
38 beginning in fiscal year 1994-95 for a part-time Clerk Typist II
position and general operating expenses to collect and
40 disseminate information as part of the Missing Children
Information Clearinghouse.

42 These funds are appropriated and allocated on a 13% General
44 Fund and 87% Highway Fund basis. The annual General Fund
appropriations total \$2,227 and Highway Fund allocations total
46 \$14,901. The Governor's proposed current services budget
includes changes that affect the distribution of State Police
48 funding. This estimate of the fiscal impact may need to be
adjusted based on final legislative actions on the current
50 services budget.'


