COMMITTEE AMENDMENT "A " to S.P. 167, L.D. 559, Bill, "An Act to Impose Term Limits on Presiding Officers of the Legislature"

Amend the bill by striking out all of sections 1 and 2 and inserting in their place the following:

Sec. 1. 3 MRSA §21-A is enacted to read:

§21-A. President of Senate; term limitation

A person may not serve as President of the Senate for more than 3 consecutive legislative bienniums. Service in that capacity before December 2, 1992 is not included in the calculation of years served.

Sec. 2. 3 MRSA §41-A is enacted to read:

§41-A. Speaker of House of Representatives; term limitation

A person may not serve as Speaker of the House of Representatives for more than 3 consecutive legislative bienniums. Service in that capacity before December 2, 1992 is not included in the calculation of years served.'

STATEMENT OF FACT

This amendment limits to 3 consecutive legislative bienniums the time a Legislator may serve as President of the Senate and Speaker of the House of Representatives.
