

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine as follows:

4 Sec. 1. 23 MRSA §1905-A is enacted to read:

6 §1905-A. Yarmouth information center pilot project

8 The Department of Transportation is authorized to designate the information center at Yarmouth as a pilot project for permitting local service clubs to sell refreshments at an information center.

12 The Department of Transportation shall adopt rules regulating the project and obtain any waivers required by the Federal Government. The department shall report to the joint standing committee of the Legislature having jurisdiction over transportation matters by January 15, 1996. The report must include the rules, an overall assessment and recommendations for the expansion or discontinuation of the pilot project.

22 STATEMENT OF FACT
