HOUSE AMENDMENT "A" to H.P. 443, L.D. 569, Bill, "An Act to Clarify the Days During Which Prisoners May Be Delivered to the Custody of the Department of Corrections"

Amend the bill by inserting before the enacting clause the following:

**'Mandate preamble.** This measure requires one or more local units of government to expand or modify activities so as to necessitate additional expenditures from local revenues but does not provide funding for at least 90% of those expenditures. Pursuant to the Constitution of Maine, Article IX, Section 21, two thirds of all of the members elected to each House have determined it necessary to enact this measure.'

Further amend the bill by inserting at the end before the statement of fact the following:

**'FISCAL NOTE**

This bill may require local units of government to make additional expenditures for holding prisoners on weekends. Pursuant to the Mandate Preamble, the 2/3 vote of all members elected to each House exempts the State from the constitutional requirement to fund 90% of the additional local cost of these requirements.'
