However, the ability of the Legislature to absorb the per diem and other expenses will depend on the final outcome of the Governor's proposed current services budget.'

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## STATEMENT OF FACT

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This amendment changes the name of the Federal Funds Advisory Committee to the Federal Funds Task Force. The amendment also changes the membership of the task force to include only legislative members. The amendment also clarifies that the task force dissolves once its report has been submitted. The amendment also requires the Legislative Council to absorb the costs of the task force within existing resources.

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The amendment also adds a fiscal note to the resolve.
