An Act Establishing an Indigent Defense Reimbursement Fund.

1. Creation of fund. The Indigent Defense Reimbursement Fund is created to offset the costs of providing representation to indigent defendants and to pay all necessary and proprexpenses incurred in collecting partial payments from indigent defendants. The judicial branch shall administer the fund. 2. Funding sources. All funds collected as the result of an indigent defendant being ordered by a court to make payment toward the cost of representation by court-appointed counse accrue to the Indigent Defense Reimbursement Fund. 3. Use of funds. Administrative and personal service expenses associated with the indigent defense screening projecting may be paid by the judicial branch from the Indigent Defense Reimbursement Fund. 4. Effective date. Notwithstanding the effective date of this section, all reimbursements collected from indigen defendants on or after July 1, 1992 accrue to the Indigen Defense Reimbursement Fund. Sec. 2. Retroactivity. This Act takes effect retroactively for July 1, 1992. Frior to July 1, 1992, all reimbursements collected from indigent defendants were credited directly to the Indigen these reimbursements such as the expenditures required to general these reimbursements such as the expenses of the indigent defense screening program.
