COMMITTEE AMENDMENT "A " to S.P. 178, L.D. 592, Bill, "An Act to Clarify the Appointment, Powers and Duties of Building Committees"

Amend the bill in section 1 in subsection 1 in the last 2 lines (page 1, lines 17 and 18 in L.D.) by striking out the following: "A special building committee once established has the powers and duties set forth in this chapter." and inserting in its place the following: 'The powers and duties of the building committee must be determined at the time of its establishment by the legislative body of the school administrative unit, or by the school board when it acts as the building committee and delegates those powers and duties to the superintendent. Powers and duties not assigned to the building committee that are not specifically delegated to other entities in this section remain with the school board.'

STATEMENT OF FACT

This amendment further clarifies the powers and duties of a public school building committee by requiring that the committee's powers and duties be determined at the time the committee is established. It also clarifies that powers and duties not assigned to the building committee or another entity remain with the school board.
