COMMITTEE AMENDMENT "A" to S.P. 190, L.D. 626, Bill, "An Act to Amend the Long-term Care Ombudsman Program"

Amend the bill in section 1 in the first paragraph in the 9th line from the end (page 1, line 33 in L.D.) by inserting after the following: "function" the following: 'except that these individuals may not make copies of confidential client information'

Further amend the bill by inserting at the end before the statement of fact the following:

FISCAL NOTE

The Department of Human Services will incur some minor additional costs to certify additional volunteers and to participate in on-site surveys or reviews. These costs can be absorbed within the department's existing budgeted resources.'

STATEMENT OF FACT

This amendment clarifies that volunteers designated by the long-term care ombudsman may not make copies of confidential client information.

The amendment also adds a fiscal note to the bill.
